## What Can I Do?



### Locations

Learn the location of the nearest safety shelter and evacuation routes.



### Numbers

Know emergency contact numbers for different situations. Load them into your cell phone.



### Family Plan

Develop a family communications plan.



### Supply Kit

Make an emergency supply kit to be prepared for any type of disaster.



### Help

Know the locations of nearby trauma centers, hospitals and acute care centers.



### Alerts

Learn about receiving emergency alerts and local emergency plans for shelter and evacuation, local emergency contacts, and local advance alerts and warnings.



### Awareness

Know which hazards are most likely to occur -- even when you are traveling.



### Training

Discover opportunities for preparedness education and training.
